Jonathon Scott Feit is Chief Editor & Publisher of *Citizen Culture*, which he co-founded at age 22. He has been among the youngest presenters at the Annual Conventions of the American Academy of Religion and the Mid-Atlantic Popular/American Culture Association, and remains one of the youngest members of the American Society of Magazine Editors, the Magazine Publishers of America, and the Independent Press Association.

Having been featured as a publishing industry expert on CNBC and published several articles in industry outlets nationwide, including the *Journal of Media and Religion*, the *Bulletin of the Council of Societies for the Study of Religion*, and the *Media Industry Newsletter*, Jonathon is one of the youngest faculty members in the College of Communication at Boston University, where he teaches "Magazine Business Development (for the 21st Century)." Jonathon has been named a "Digital Driver" by the Magazine Publishers of America.

Jonathon earned a combined Bachelor's and Master's degree *cum laude* in "Psychology, Religion, & Conflict Negotiations" from the University Professors Program at Boston University. He has trained in mediation at the Straus Institute for Dispute Resolution at the Pepperdine University School of Law, the nation's top dispute resolution program, and studied business law and entrepreneurship at Johns Hopkins University and the Boston University School of Management.
